Terms and Conditions for the St Brigid's Day Giveaway

1. Organiser

The giveaway is organised by Irish Studies Wuppertal, located at the University of Wuppertal. Contact: Prof. Dr. Katharina Rennhak. The novels are donated to Irish Studies Wuppertal by the Embassy of Ireland in Germany.

2. Duration of the Giveaway

The giveaway runs from 14 April 2025 to 18 July 2025. The lecture-free Pentecost week (09 June 2025 to 13 June 2025) is excluded. Each weekly round begins on Monday and ends on Friday at 23:59 CEST. Entries submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

3. Eligibility

Participation is open to all students currently enrolled at the University of Wuppertal who are at least 18 years old at the time of entry. Participants must provide their matriculation number as proof of enrollment. The organisers and their immediate family members are excluded from participation.

4. How to Participate

Each week a question will be posted on the <u>website</u> of Irish Studies in Wuppertal. To enter the giveaway, participants must submit the correct answer via the online form by Friday, 23:59 CEST of the respective week. Only one entry per person per week is allowed.

5. Prize and Winner Selection

Each week, several books will be given away. Winners will be drawn at random from all correct entries and notified via email. If a winner fails to collect their book at the English Department within 14 days of being notified, a new winner may be selected. Prizes cannot be exchanged for cash or other items.
